Paul Grahn was born in Watertown, NY on January 2, 1933, the only child of Paul and Frieda Grahn. He graduated from Wittenberg University in Springfield, Ohio with a B.A. in accounting. After serving in the U.S. Navy during a Mid-East conflict of the 50's, he worked as an auditor in the insurance industry for 39 years.

Paul came from a devout Lutheran family and was treasurer of St. Timothy Lutheran Church of Tarpon Springs, FL for many years.

The Grahns, who had lived in Florida for 46 years, began spending time in Tellico Plains and in 1996 purchased property with a cabin in "Lake of the Woods", building a larger log cabin nearby with a majestic view of the mountains in 2009.

Paul, with his wife Ingrid, and twin daughters, Carol and Suzie, became active and faithful members of Center Presbyterian Church in 2008.

Paul, who was truly a gentle man, loved the outdoors, especially boating and camping. But most of all, he loved God, his family and his country.
