He graduated from UT with a commission of Second Lieutenant in the United States Air Force Reserves in 1962. He served two tours in Viet Nam. Tim and Sandi have lived in Georgetown, CO-Conifer, CO-Sandy, UT and for the last 18 years in Tellico Plains.
